

VILLAGE OF GLASFORD
BOARD MEETING MINUTES – JULY 16, 2020

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Village Board of Glasford was convened at 7:00pm. In attendance were Mayor Rudd, Clerk Stetler, Trustees Allen, Randle, Whaley and Sheckler. Trustees Kingsley and Pilgrim were absent. Also in attendance were Streets/Maint. Supt. Reimer; Chief Beachler; Nanette Rudd; and Jason Cohee.

Motion to approve June 18, 2020 board meeting minutes made by Whaley, 2nd by Allen. Roll call: ALLEN-AYE; RANDLE-AYE; WHALEY-AYE; SHECKLER-AYE. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion to pay bills made by Whaley, 2nd by Allen. Roll call: ALLEN-AYE; RANDLE-AYE; WHALEY-AYE; SHECKLER-AYE. All ayes, motion carried.

Nanette Rudd gave Board status update on the car show scheduled for July 26, 2020 from 9:00am to 3:00pm on Main Street. Discussion followed.

Jason Cohee voiced opinion regarding the procedure for getting a referendum for a City Manager. Discussion followed. Mayor Rudd informed Mr. Cohee that the Board will not seek a referendum for City Manager.

Jason Cohee inquired about if the Village had an ordinance for part-time police officers as required by state law. Discussion followed. Mr. Cohee was informed that Ordinance 2012-09 had been passed on this issue.

Jason Cohee asked Chief Beachler if the new K-9 Unit is trained for bite & hold and if there was a certificate for it. Discussion followed. Chief Beachler informed Mr. Cohee that the K-9 is trained on bite and hold, but the State of Illinois does not issue a certificate for the training.

Mayor Rudd gave status update on purchase of 608 S. Glasford Road property. Discussion followed.



Jason Cohee asked of Chief Beachler and the Board about supervising positions in police department on how a part-time officer cannot supervise a full-time officer. Discussion followed. Chief Beachler informed Mr. Cohee that the Village does not have any full-time police officers, however, officers are on call 24/7 and can be called to duty if needed for a situation.

Jason Cohee informed Chief Beachler that one item of personal information was not redacted on a FOIA request he made for police records to the police department. Chief Beachler responded that due to the numerous FOIA requests in past few weeks, unfortunately this was overlooked and he would inform the FOIA Records officer so this issue would be prevented in the future.
