READING of June 17, 2021 board meeting minutes.

Motion to approve June 17, 2021 minutes, made by Allen, 2nd by Randle. Roll call: ALLEN—AYE; RANDLE—AYE; ARNOLD—AYE; GODBY—AYE; SHECKLER. Roll call . . . all ayes. Motion carried.

Jason Cohee requested of the Board to pass an Ordinance to limit the feeding of free roaming cats and racoons in the Village limits. Discussion followed. Board determined that there was not a need for this type of ordinance at this time.

Connie Wall requested of the Board that something be done about abandoned house on 314 W. Main Street. Discussion followed. Attorney Rhonda Heinz to send letter to property owner regarding condition of property and the violations of Village Code said property is in violation of as of July 15, 2021.

STREETS and MAINTENANCE REPORT was presented by Mayor Rudd in Supt. Reimer's absent. Report accepted.

POLICE REPORT reported and accepted.
