

**VILLAGE OF GLASFORD**  
**BOARD MEETING MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 16, 2021**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Village Board of Glasford was convened at 7:00pm. In attendance were Mayor Rudd, Clerk Stetler, Trustees Allen, Randle, Arnold, Godby, and Kingsley. Trustee Sheckler was absent. Also in attendance were Streets/Maintenance Supt. Reimer; Chief Beachler; William Knott, Michele and Randy Voss.

READING of August 19, 2021 board meeting minutes. Motion to accept and approve August 19, 2021 minutes made by Randle, 2nd by Kingsley. Roll call: ALLEN—AYE; RANDLE—AYE; ARNOLD—AYE; GODBY—AYE; KINGSLEY—AYE. Roll call . . . all ayes. Motion carried.

Randy Voss presented to the Board points on why the Board should vacate S. Hickory Street at the intersection of E. Fifth Street. Discussion followed.

Motion to proceed with the vacation process of S. Hickory Street at the intersection of E. Fifth Street and to hold public hearing on October 21, 2021 at 6:30pm regarding said vacation, made by Arnold, 2nd by Randle. Roll call: ALLEN—AYE; RANDLE—AYE; ARNOLD—AYE; GODBY—AYE; KINGSLEY—NAYE. Motion to approve to purchase candy treat bags, glow necklaces and other Halloween supplies for Halloween Parade on October 31, 2021, made by Kingsley, 2nd by Allen. Roll call: ALLEN—AYE; RANDLE—AYE; ARNOLD—AYE; GODBY—AYE; KINGSLEY—AYE. Roll call . . . all ayes. Motion carried.

Clerk presented to the Board that the Village is to receive an allotment of \$130,098.61 from the Federal Fiscal Recovery Funds. Discussion followed.
