**BOARD MEETING MINUTES –MARCH 16, 2023**

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

Trustee Allen entered meeting at 7:05pm.

William Knott addressed the Board about the vacant house at E. Seventh St. and S. Glasford Road. Discussion followed. Mayor Rudd to contact the owner of property regarding the condition of the property.

Postponed from February 16, 2023 meeting, determination of whether or not to accept Harris Services bid of \$175/mow or Village to purchase own mower. Trustee Kingsley presented to the Board two (2) quotes for lawn mowers. Tremont Sales for a Ferris 3330/61" for \$15,750.00 and from German-Bliss Equipment for an Exmark Lazer X-Series/60" for \$15,039.00. Discussion followed.
